**FEAST REGISTRATION OPENS ON APRIL 24, 2016, 10 A.M. ET**

To enable us to have the online registration process run smoothly, we have changed the date of U.S. Festival registration to Sunday, April 24. We ask that ALL COGWA households please complete the online Festival registration process—whether you are attending in the U.S. or internationally. We also ask that those NOT attending the Feast please register as well—as this gives us more accurate figures for planning. Members without Internet access will be assisted by their local Festival adviser.

Beginning at 10 a.m. Eastern time on Sunday, April 24, members can begin accessing the <http://feast.cogwa.org/> web page for Feast registration. The email address of the registrant will be used to identify that person's or family's registration account.

After accessing the COGWA Feast web page, simply click on the "REGISTRATION" button and begin the process. This first step will set up your registration portal account—unless you already have one. Those of you who registered for either the Young Adult Leadership Weekend in February OR our COGWA Youth Camps for 2016 will already have your email and password set. You do not need to set up another account.

After completing that first step, all registrants will then receive a confirmation email almost immediately. To complete the registration process, simply access that email, click on the link provided and finish the Festival registration (site selection, volunteer information, etc.) for you and each member of your household. Please be sure to complete the sections asking about "special needs," if any exist.

We also encourage all of our members to consider how they might wish to SERVE at the Feast, as this information will be requested as part of the registration process as well.

## **NEW CAMP REGISTRATION SYSTEM**

In order to serve you better, we have created our own system for camp applications and registrations, and it is now open for applications. Please note there are two main steps to applying for camp with the new system.

1. Create a household account on the COGWA portal and add your spouse, if applicable, and any members of your household who wish to apply for camp.
2. When you log into your account, COGWA Youth Camps 2016 will show in the Upcoming Events section with a link to begin the application process.

Since the system is new, we have created a tutorial on how to use it, and we strongly encourage you to read it before you start your application. It is the "Applying for Camp – Start Here" article on the home page of the camp website, [camps.coqwa.org](http://camps.coqwa.org). You can also find it by clicking on the Apply button on the navigation bar then clicking the link in the second sentence to read the article/tutorial. You can then go back to the Apply page to start the process.

## **DALLAS PICNIC – JUNE 19<sup>TH</sup> AT SANDY LAKE AMUSEMENT PARK**

The Dallas picnic will be held Sunday, June 19th, at the Sandy Lake amusement park, 10 am - 6 pm. We will have a catered barbecue meal provided by Sandy Lake at our own pavilion. You must sign up on the list at the information table if you plan to attend.

Please pay close attention to the following details: The church activity fund will cover the cost of the meal (\$15), the park entrance fee (\$2 per person), and swimming tickets (\$5). However, you must register each person (over the age of 3) ahead of time on the sign-up list at the information table. Those who register will receive a meal ticket ahead of time and then enter the park for free by showing your meal ticket. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL BE CHARGED \$2 PER PERSON WHEN ENTERING THE PARK. The BBQ meal comes with iced tea, but feel free to bring your own drinks and other snacks for the rest of the day. Beer is also permitted, but bring cans only (no glass bottles). Sandy Lake has a snack bar available. Also, you may want to bring your own lawn or camp chairs, as they only have tables and benches at the pavilion. Sandy Lake offers miniature golf and 19 amusement rides that range in cost from \$1.50 to \$3. Tickets for the rides may be purchased at the ticket booth (CASH ONLY; NO CREDIT CARDS; there is an ATM at the park). When you sign up, please indicate if you want swim tickets, as we will purchase those at the park that day. Sandy Lake information fliers are available at the information table, so please take time to check out the details. Since the entire cost of the activity is coming out of the activity fund (\$15 per person meal, \$5 per person for swimming), if members choose to bring guests (e.g., family members who do not attend regularly with us), we ask that members pay separately for these guests.
